EXPRESSION OF LIFE SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

Eligibility – Seniors planning to enter the field of performing or visual arts, essay.

Amount - \$500

Deadline – May 1, 2012

HUGGABLE HEROES SCHOLARSHIP

Eligibility – Students ages 8-18 who go to extraordinary lengths to make the world a better place.

Amount - \$7500

Deadline – February 27, 2012

JOHN GREEN MEMORIAL AWARD AT ROWAN UNIVERSITY

Eligibility – Exhibits good academic scholarship, outstanding leadership, matriculate at Rowan University.

Amount - \$600 per year for four years

Deadline – March 9, 2012

*One student will be nominated from interested applicants.

FOSTER AND ADOPTIVE FAMILY SERVICES SCHOLARSHIP

Eligibility – Foster/adopted seniors who have been under the care of DYFS.

Amount – Varies

Deadline – March 16, 2012

JULIE RIGGI KRMS SCHOLARSHIP

Eligibility – Senior in good standing both academically and behaviorally. Must have attended Kingsway Middle School for his or her seventh and eighth grade years.

Amount TBD

Deadline – April 30, 2012

DELTA SIGMA THETA SORORITY SCHOLARSHIP

Eligibility – African-American females, essay

Amount - \$1,500

Deadline – March 30, 2012

JOHN J. ADAMS, ESQ. MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Eligibility – Seniors with at least a 3.0 GPA, interest in history, politics, or current events and issues, submit an original work in the form of a poem, short story, political cartoon or song.

Amount - \$500 or \$250

Deadline – May 1, 2012

WOOLWICH TOWNSHIP DEMOCRATIC CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

Eligibility – Woolwich resident who has demonstrated good citizenship, essay.

Amount – To be determined

Deadline – March 30, 2012

HARRISONVILLE RURITAN CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

Eligibility – Senior student, resident of South Harrison, essay question.

Amount - \$1,000 and \$500

Deadline – March 16, 2012

SWACKHAMER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Eligibility – Christian males, 2.5 GPA, financial need.

Amount – Varies

Deadline – March 19, 2012

TOURETTE SYNDROME ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP

Eligibility – Diagnosis of Tourette Syndrome, essay, DVD or CD, attend college or trade school.

Amount – TBA

Deadline – April 5, 2012

ETS EMPLOYEES' COMMUNITY ACTION FUND SCHOLARSHIP

Eligibility – Financial hardship, attend 2 or 4 year college or vocational/technical school.

Amount - \$5,000

Deadline – March 1, 2012

NJUA EXCELLENCE IN DIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIP

Eligibility – Minority, female or disabled students pursuing a Bachelor's degree, financial need.

Amount - \$1,500 per year (4 years)

Deadline – March 31, 2012

NJUA TRADE AND VOCATIONAL SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP

Eligibility – Pursuing a trade or vocational degree.

Amount – Up to \$6000

Deadline – March 31, 2012

**NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF WATER COMPANIES
SCHOLARSHIP**

Eligibility – New Jersey resident for a least 5 years, will be attending a New Jersey college or university, display an interest in the water utility industry or in any related field, such as natural resource management, environmental sciences, biology, chemistry, engineering, communications, computer science, business administration, human resources, consumer affairs, law, accounting, finance.

Amount - \$2,500

Deadline – March 31, 2012

NATIONAL COALITION OF 100 BLACK WOMEN SCHOLARSHIP

Eligibility – Minority females who have demonstrated a commitment to service in school and/or their communities, as well as academic excellence.

Amount - \$500

Deadline – February 18, 2012
